Race-Driven Brake Pads

Let me start by saying "Thank you" to Just-Add-Dirt for putting me into contact with Brian at Race-Driven. Race-Driven is a great company to work with. I have experience with stock pads, EBC, and a couple different knock off brands purchased on ebay. The Race-Driven brake pads stop my quad as well as any of them, and they last considerably longer.



This pair of OEM pads is completely roached after 6 weeks of normal riding.

The stock pads that came on my quad stopped predictably and wore very well, but that when my quad was brand new and I kept it clean and out of the mud. After I got used to it, and began to submerge the brakes in the slop they began to wear, in fact with the riding I do (mostly trails with lots of water and mud), replacement OEM pads have been lasting about 6-8 weeks and are always completely worn down when I change them out.

In comparison, my Race-Driven pads, after 8 weeks of water and sand trails, mud holes that monster trucks couldn't get across, as well as a lot of water "over the rack" deep, are still only half worn. That's literally twice the life

I've gotten out of any other pad!

The other thing to note was the service. Race-Driven is a responsive and friendly company to do business with. My brake pads were shipped the same day and I received it in three days.
